Hart, Pink plan to surf on Coast

FREESTYLE motocross champion Carey Hart will ride into the Gold Coast this month with his rock star wife Pink – and the celebrity couple say they can't wait to catch some waves at our famous beaches.

"We're looking forward to surfing, we love the ocean and being close to the water," said Hart yesterday.

The couple's visit is part of a nationwide trip encompassing his motocross Hart & Huntington Freestyle Tour and her live Funhouse tour.

Hart, 33, said it was an opportunity for the pair to rekindle their relationship after their separation last year.

"This was our first attempt to cross paths on a business level because we want to focus on our relationship," he said.

"It's been great so far, we've

been able to spend time together when she's not doing her shows and I'm not doing mine.

"There's nothing worse than seeing typical celebrity split-ups ... but we have an amazing friendship.

"We've been in each other's lives for seven years and we're out to protect each other and be there for each other. The fun and romance comes with it."

Hart said the Hart & Huntington Freestyle Tour at Parklands Showgrounds on June 20 would be the final leg of the tour and would 'go off with a bang'.

"We're going to cut it as the 'super show'," he said.

"We have Bilko (Blake Williams) coming out for it, Mike Mason and (Cam) Sinclair."

The free event includes a daring FMX show starring Hart, who was the first person in the world to backflip a 250cc motorcycle.

"It got me the most publicity, but it got me my worst injuries," said Hart of the stunt.

"I broke 16 bones at once – my legs, my wrists. . . but I always get back on the bike because I'm passionate about it."

The tour program also includes stunt demonstrations, custom

bikes and cars, street art, music and fashion.

"We are all too aware of what Australians have been enduring with the floods, fires and financial crisis so we decided it was time everyone had the opportunity to have a good time," he said.

"Australia and its people have been so good to my wife and I over the years – we honestly feel like this is our home away from home."

Hart and Pink married after Pink proposed at one of Hart's races in 2005. She held a pit board with the words: 'Will You Marry Me?' while he was racing.

"It was pure shock, I came skidding off the track," Hart recalled.

"I got out and said 'yes' and she said 'get your ass back in the race because I don't marry losers'."

Hart said their reunion had strengthened their desire to one day have children.

"We're definitely having kids, 100 per cent," he said.

"I don't know how many. Pink has a new niece and we get to be around the baby . . . she's getting a bit clucky."
