When did you become interested in motocross riding?

I got my first motorcycle when I was four and I started racing when I was six – I just caught the fever. My dad and both my uncles used to race and so did my grandfather. It's definitely in the family.

If you could do any other job, what would it be?

Formula One or Moto GP . . . I just love racing and speed and jumping and all of it.

When was the last time you were embarrassed?

I'm constantly putting my foot in my mouth at the wrong time, saying something without really thinking.

Which do you wear – boxers or briefs?
