Aerial spectacular is Hart warming

AREY Hart was the first person to successfully land a backflip on a motorcycle. That makes him a legend in the world of freestyle motocross, but he is also known around the world (right) as the other half of singer Pink.

Now the pair are joining forces with something special for Australia — a series of free “events” in the main cities, where Pink is performing on her latest tour.

There will be art, music and fashion but, best of all, a combination of cars and bikes and FMX action.

Hart is recruiting a team of Australia’s best aerial bike experts and they will join him at five

local shows, in the Hart & Huntington Freestyle Tour, from Melbourne to the Gold Coast from May 30 to June 20.

“We’re all too aware of what Australians have been enduring with the fires, floods and financial crisis, so we decided it was time everyone had the opportunity to have a good time,” Hart says.

“Australia and its people have been so good to my wife and I over the years and we honestly feel this is our home away from home.

“We want this to be a real reward for fans of the sport and wider culture that has provided me with so many opportunities.”

The tour has backing from

Holden and will start at Rod Laver Arena on May 30, moving to Newcastle, Sydney, Brisbane and the Gold Coast finale on June 20.
