



Hart aims to add to Pink fun

SYDNEY — Singer Pink's husband, Carey Hart, will hold a series of free motocross events around her upcoming Funhouse tour, as the couple rebuild their relationship in Australia.

Based on his tattoo shop and clothing brand, the Hart and Huntington Freestyle Tour will be a celebration of motocross and the associated art, fashion, music, bikes, cars and culture.

The three-hour events will be held ahead of selected shows on Pink's 42-date Australian tour, in Melbourne, Newcastle, Sydney, Brisbane and the Gold Coast.

Hart, a freestyle motocross star, came up with the idea of putting on and starring in the free shows as a way to give something back to Australian fans.

"Australia is very good to Pink and that's why it was so

exciting for me," Hart said from Las Vegas.

"If we're going to do something free and give back to people, it's in Australia."

Pink and Hart married in 2006.

In February last year the star couple announced they had separated, but they have recently started seeing each other again.
