



Husband moves from doohouse to Funhouse

CAREY Hart, the husband of pop star Pink, will hold free motocross events around her *Funhouse* tour, as the couple rebuild their relationship in Australia.

His tour, based on his tattoo shop and clothing brand, will be a celebration of motocross and the associated art, fashion, music, bikes, cars and culture.

The three-hour events will be held before some shows on Pink's 42-date Australian tour, in Melbourne, Newcastle, Sydney, Brisbane and the Gold Coast.

The Newcastle event is due to be held at the Entertainment Centre on Thursday, June 4.

The Sydney events will be held at Sydney Entertainment Centre on Saturday, June 6.

Hart, a freestyle motocross star, has organised the free shows as a way to give something back to Australian fans.

"It is tough for people out there nowadays to go spend a lot of money on a ticket to go to a tour or music festival," Hart said from Las Vegas, in the US desert state of Nevada.

"Australia is very good to Pink and that's why it was so exciting for me. If we're going to do something free and give back to people, it's in Australia."

Pink and Hart met in Las Vegas at the 2001 X Games and married five years later.

The couple separated in February last year but began seeing each other again.

Hart said the Australian tour was a chance to spend some quality time together.

"We're definitely working on our relationship," he said.

"This was actually one of the first steps. We had to come up with a way to be able to both go to work and both see each other.

"It's going to be a very exciting time for both of us to actually go to Australia and tour together for two months."

Hart said he hoped to convert some of Pink's fans to motocross and was looking forward to some surfing and travelling the open road with Pink.
